Tuesday, October 17, 2017 10am**

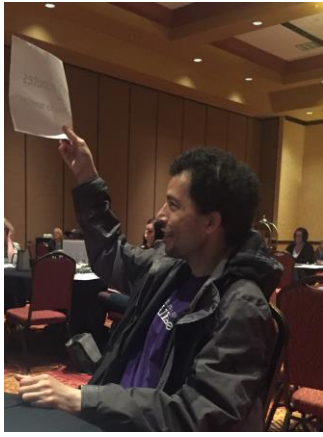

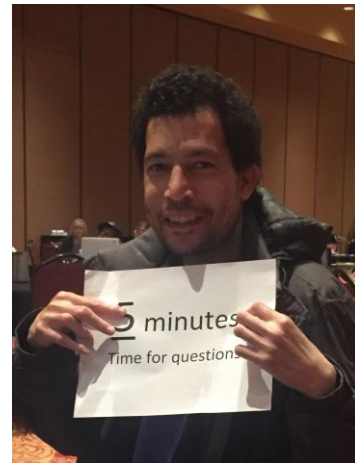
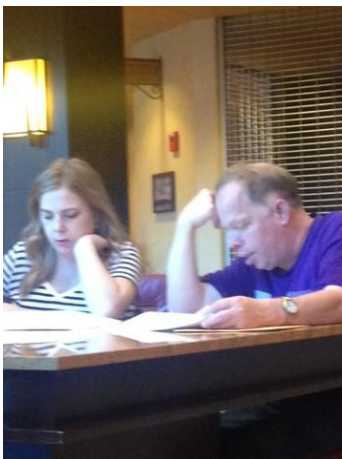
